- THE COMPANY AT THE HEART OF THE JOURNEY: company involvement in the programme with activities such as reversed interaction, immersion periods, interview simulation, job dating or meetups, etc.

As the lead trainer:

Your role will be to provide web developer training. You will help participants carry out their projects on a day-to-day basis. You will also be responsible for ensuring that the course and learner progress are rolled out correctly.

In this respect, your main tasks will be to:

- Participate in recruiting trainees
- Be accountable for the technical and andragogical coherence of the programme
- Lead collective training sessions
- Assess the progress of trainees



- Liaise with the technical experts and others contributing to the programme
- Ensure coordination internally with colleagues supporting the trainees, as well as liaising with others as needed.

You will also be required to:

- Encourage meetings between participants and the developer community (meetups, participation in local events, etc.)
- Monitor and guide the group in its daily activities: learning by teaching activities, workshops, meetings, etc.
- Participate in enhancing OPPORTUNITY's training practice via meetings of the trainer community
- Contribute to supplying the Simplon trainer Github for trainees

- Knowledge of node is a plus
