- participating in the recruitment of the trainees within the cohort

- mobilizing innovative andragogical techniques
- supervising the advancement of the trainees
- encouraging meetings between the trainees and the community of people working in the digital world, particularly through integrating it within the curriculum (i.e. scheduling meetups, participation in local events, etc.)
- accompanying the cohort in carrying out the tasks and work given to them
- participating in andragogical meetings between réalise and Zurich Opportunity
- regularly raising issues on the training and the cohort
